

Call for Authors

NAEA is interested in receiving submissions for the *NAEA Advisory* series on topics related to issues of instruction, curriculum and strategies for teaching. Also desired are papers on topics related to application of the National Standards in Art, specifically in relation to strategies for incorporation and implementation in curricula in K-12 schools.

The *NAEA Advisory* is intended as a vehicle for the dissemination of practice related information which is grounded in research on teaching in both art education and general education fields.

Other possible topics for consideration might include:

- strategies for instruction based on educational research
- strategies for classroom organization and behavior management
 - assessment procedures related to art learning
- art pedagogy; ie, depth verses breadth approaches, etc.
 - alternative methods for teaching using technology
 - art instruction and higher-order thinking
 - issues related to teacher preparation
- the incorporation of multiple-intelligences theories
 - conducting research in the art classroom
 - instructional practices in other cultures
 - art instruction in community contexts

Text submitted for the *NAEA Advisory* should be no longer than 3-4 pages double-spaced including references (600-700 words) and should follow the format outlined in the fourth edition of the American Psychological Association (APA) Manual.
